

# PINKBABYHEAD STENCIL INSTRUCTIONS

you will need:



pink spray paint  
(rust-oleum “candy pink”)  
black spray paint  
an exacto knife  
a sheet of stencil plastic  
(at hobby or art supply stores)  
masking tape or spray adhesive

## **Step 1: Print out the Babyhead.**

Set your printer on “draft” or “fast” if you want to save ink.

## **Step 2: Cut out the Babyhead.**

Attach the stencil plastic to the paper with tape or spray adhesive so you can see the image through the plastic. Then carefully cut out the pink parts. When you are done, remove the paper and keep the plastic.

## **Step 3: The Background.**

The pinkbabyhead needs a black background on a smooth surface, so either find one, or make one by spray painting a surface black.

## **Step 4: The Head.**

When the black surface is dry, hold the stencil against it, making sure there are no gaps. Spray the pink onto all open areas in the stencil. You can wear a latex or vinyl glove on the hand that holds the stencil so you don't paint yourself.
